"Pale straw in the glass with a striking nose of juicy white peach, citrus and nectarine fruits underscored by dreamy, cashew-like French oak, white flowers, oatmeal, almond paste and stone. Fans out beautifully with a textural, light-phenolic tweak and a lovely white peach, citrus and roasted nut flourish."
