"The old vine Shiraz and Grenache fruit is sourced from the organically certified Warboys Vineyard. Aromas of brush and black cherry are tethered to an earthiness that continues on the palate. Black pepper takes hold of juicy plum and black cherry. A graceful and extroverted acid structure carries the fruit to a long, lengthy stay on the palate. Cigar leaf, sage and red pepper are just the right ammunition for a savory finish."
