"Tangy, up-front blueberry, plum and black currant open, underpinned by savory spice and cola. The palate is full bodied, round and plump, with oodles of ripe fruit and powerful tannins. Drink now with protein."

"Angove Family Crest 2019 Shiraz is a vegan friendly McLaren Vale Shiraz and excellent value at \$20. Dry, medium-plus-bodied and vibrant with juicy dark cherry, dark chocolate, red plum, baking spice and smoky vanilla flavours layered and luxurious on the palate. Tannins are velvety. Beautifully-crafted and a perfect pairing to a roast leg of lamb. Enjoy it now or cellar to 2027."

"This is a quite dense, savoury shiraz with a complex nose led by cherry/smokey notes, rosemary, capers, pepper, black cherry and licorice. It is full bodied, fairly dense and firm with considerable tannin. Good flavour depth and intensity with a dry and again, savoury, finish. The length is excellent. This could be nicely for five years, but also approachable now."

"This does not come across as big or powerful, but it is very well balanced and is supple, succulent and delicious. The souring acidity is a feature, adding freshness and keeping the palate lithe. Understated yet excellent, this took a day for the fruit to really build depth, so cellaring seems a good idea."

"Deep and youthful red/purple colour. The bouquet is smoky, chappy and chocolaty, blackberry joining in on the palate. It's rich and full-bodied, with plenty of tannins but a nice soft texture. A full-bodied, gutsy shiraz that will reward some cellaring. Excellent value!"
