Cool white peach, almong, a little citrus and spice. It has a light gloss, solid acid cut, pleasant flavour, and a handy finish. It's good value and a nice Chardonnay drink."

"Chardonnay from a single vineyard in the Adelaide Hills. It's a lean-ish style but it has excellent length and a little extra time in bottle should bring the necessary flesh. "This good-value 2019 chardonnay is green-tinted light gold, passionfruit-scented and fresh nectarine flavoured on the front palate. The middle palate has pear, mineral, crushed almond and cashew oak and a slatey acid finish. It comes from two Adelaide Hills vineyards, one which lost all its 2020 crop to fire and smoke taint and the other was undamaged."
