The Real Review - Stuart Knox - February 2022 - 93 Points

"Deep ruby-red colour, almost opaque at its core in the glass. Dark berries, mocha, and peppermint hints on the nose. Big and powerful, with dark fruits that are contrasted with a black olive tapenade savoury line. Great length that is driven by powerful fine-grained tannins that will offer great longevity."

"Good depth of bright colour tinged with purple, the bouquet likewise fresh and bright, this time with super-ripe blackberry jam leading the way. Sweet fruit and a dash of cherry oak in the centre. A bold, straightforward wine, with plenty of fruit and potential to develop further complexity in time. There is a little bitterness in the tannins which also suggests more time."

"A rich and intense nose with ripe dark plum and berry fruit aromas as well as slate and dark peppery elements and some dark spices. You can detect light liquorice notes, a vineyard signature. The palate has a supple and fleshy texture, effortless flavours and depth. Old vines planted in the 1930s. From organically grown grapes."

"Deep ruby, purple rim. Ripe, juicy, black cherry, prune, cassis, and cream. Palate intense, juicy, fleshy, blackcurrant, cream, vanilla, toast, and fine high dry tannin a touch dusty. The core is delicious blackcurrant and cherry fruit with some spice, touch of warmth. Very good and hard not to drink. Generous and creamy a touch minty on the finish. Hint of warmth."
